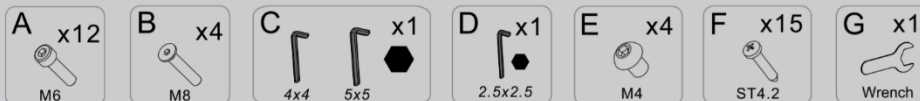

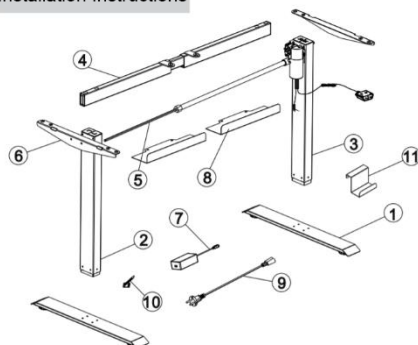

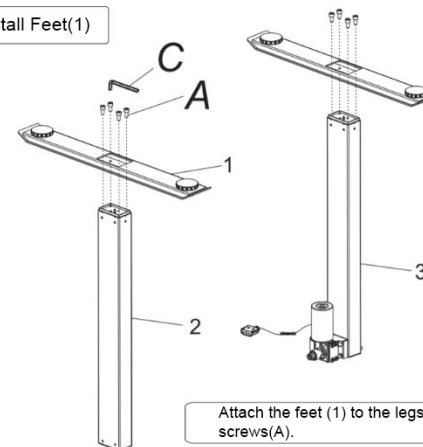

### Installation Instructions



### STEP1

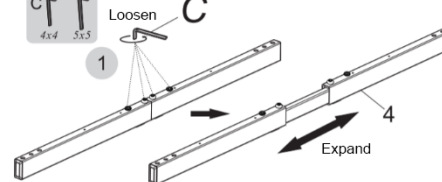
#### Install Feet(1)



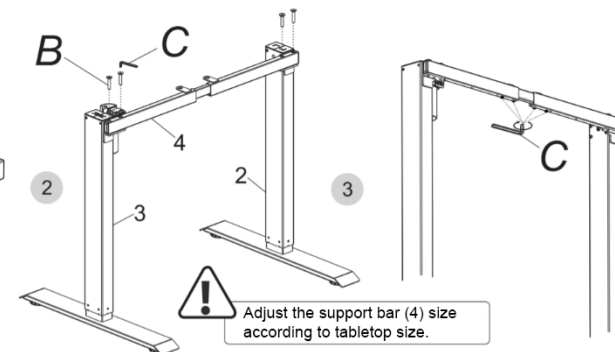
Attach the feet (1) to the legs (2 & 3), using the wrench (C) to tighten the screws(A).

### STEP2

#### Install Support Bar (4)



Loosen screws on support bar (4) using the wrench (C), and adjust its size as required.

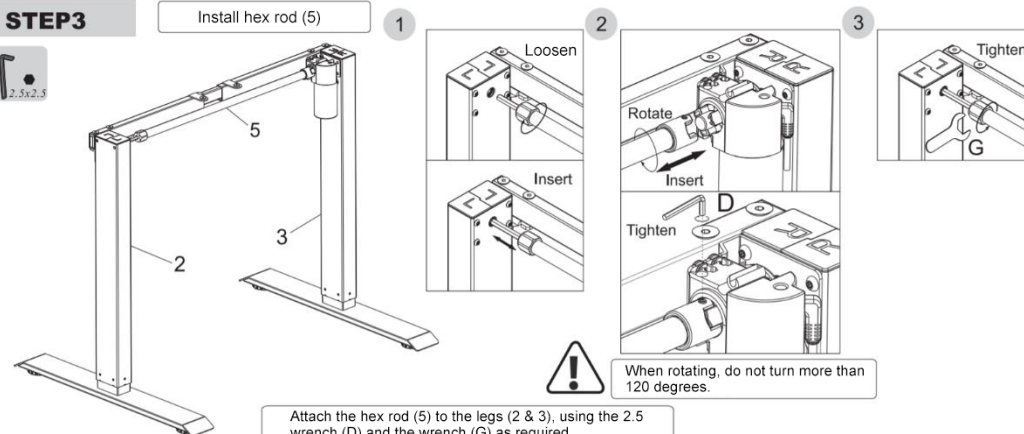


Install the support bar (4) on the legs (2 & 3) using the included screws (B) and wrench (C).

Tighten the screws on the support bar using the wrench.

### STEP3

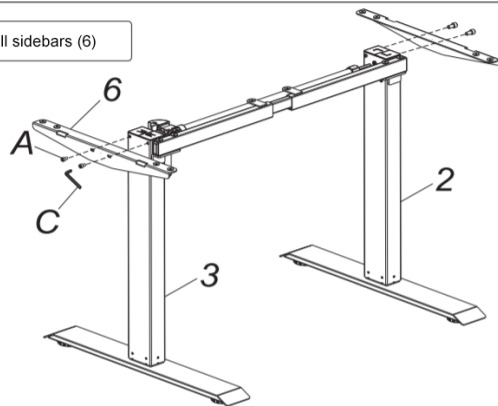
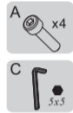
#### Install hex rod (5)



Attach the hex rod (5) to the legs (2 & 3), using the 2.5 wrench (D) and the wrench (G) as required.

#### STEP4

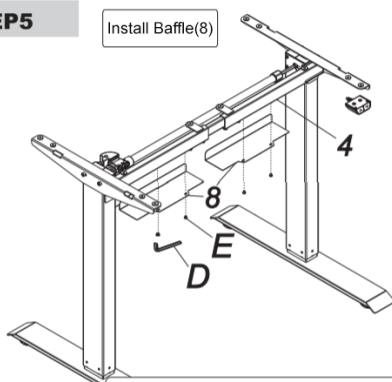
Install sidebars (6)



Attach sidebars (6) to the legs (2&3), use the wrench (C) to tighten the screws (A).

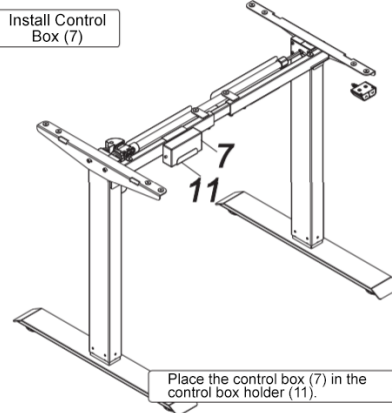
#### STEP5

Install Baffle(8)



Attach baffle (8) to the support bar using the included screws (E) and the 2.5 wrench (D).

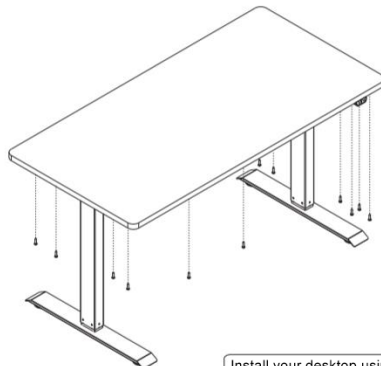
Install Control Box (7)



Place the control box (7) in the control box holder (11).

#### STEP6

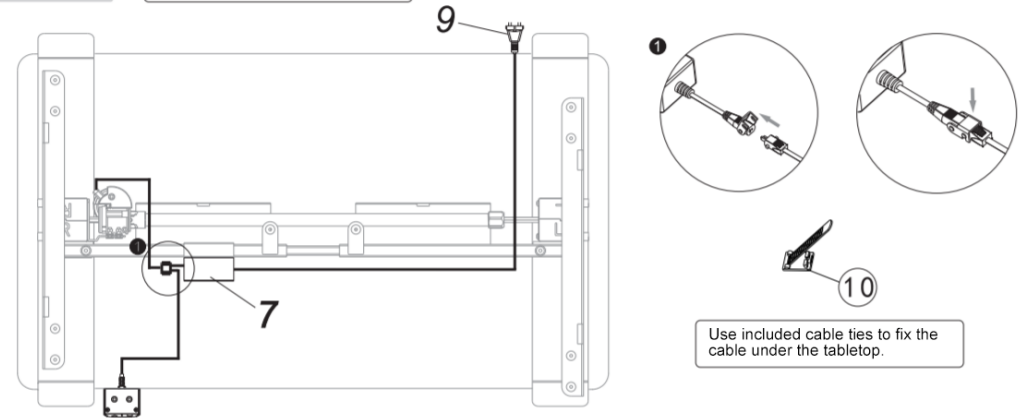
Install tabletop



Install your desktop using the included screws (F), a drill is recommended for this step.

#### STEP7

Connect cables to the control box (7)

#### Instructions

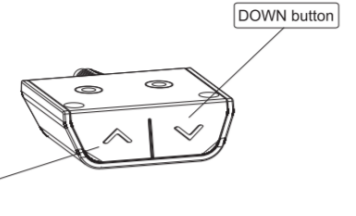
Press the UP or DOWN button to increase or decrease the height of the desk.

Issue	Fix
No response when pressing a button.	1.- Check if all cables are well-connected 2.- Contact support
Desk does not go up	1.- Check if overloaded. Max. loading: 70kg. 2.- Contact support
Desk wobbles (It may wobble slightly on carpet)	1.- Check that all bolts are tightened correctly 2.- Contact support

#### Buttons



#### Attention

1. Power supply: AC100V~240V, 50/60Hz
2. Service Environment: 0-40°C
3. Unplug the power plug before cleaning, wipe the dust on surface with slight wet dishcloth when cleaning, be careful not to let the drops into the internal parts, not loose the connector.
4. The electric box contains electronic components, metals, plastics, wires etc., so dispose of it in accordance with each country's environmental legislation, not the general household waste.
